If your child still struggles with numbers: write numbers 1 - 10 in correct formation and play Matching to help correctly identify numbers 1 - 10



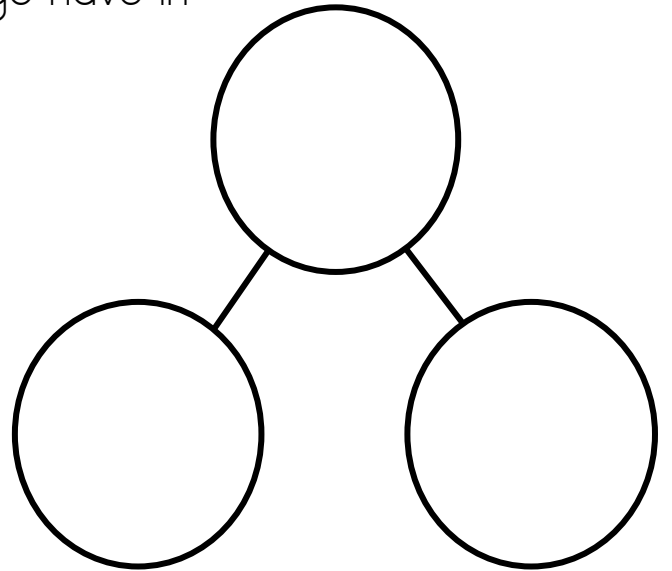
